If the seal is too difficult to break, intended users such as paramedics may not be able to open it in a careful enough manner to prevent contamination while opening the product.



Something else that is key to consider when choosing medical packaging, is making sure that it is sturdy under even the most strenuous conditions. This means making sure that packaging for medical devices will not be compromised during even difficult shipping situations, such as more extreme temperatures or altitude. This is incredibly important, because compromised packaging could mean a compromised medical device. However, packaging does not only need to be durable when it comes to shipping. Packaging for medical devices also has to be durable enough to withstand the test of time. Packaging for medical devices may very well have to be subjected to a wear test of sorts. Often this involves baking the packaging at high enough heat to simulate the aging effects of being shelved for long periods of time (all at a quicker rate than having to wait for packaging to actually deteriorate in shelving conditions). In order for a medical device to claim an expiration date, the packaging it is in must be able to withstand the test of time to make it intact and in good working order until that expiration date.
