

Cyst Removal London: Causes, Risks, Types

People may develop cysts on their body. They are of different types and hence, getting to know them will enable you to stay calm and stop panicking. The cyst is rather a closed pocket containing semi-solid substances or fluid. They are mostly benign and often mistaken to be an abscess or tumour.



How does it occur?

Cysts may occur due to some kind of blockage taking place at the area where the gland occurs on the body. It may be a hair follicle or a salivary gland. Cysts might vary in size. It may be like a large ball or perhaps very tiny to be seen. However, as they occur under the skin, they are noticeable, thereby feeling or protruding like a lump.

Common types

Noticeable cysts that appear commonly on the human body are 'sebaceous cysts' or epidermoid cysts. They may develop anywhere or under the skin. However, it is in the scalp or trunk region that they mostly appear. But being a layman, you may not be able to identify the type. Causes

Blockage occurring in the duct area may cause cysts. This could be due to inherited tendency, infection or trauma. The cyst type may depend on its area of occurrence. A few might be internal like in kidneys, ovaries and breast. Others may be external, thus being easily visible to anyone, thus causing embarrassment. Hence, consulting the certified doctor will allow you to get proper and correct treatment.

Risk factors to consider

There are certain risk factors that might increase cyst formation chances. It includes certain genetic disorders, being past puberty, chronic inflammatory conditions, cellular defects and injuries caused to the skin. Some activities such as gymnastics may place stress upon the wrist, thereby causing formation of ganglion cysts. It is typically caused on the ankle or wrist area, thereby forming visible, large lump that is filled with viscous, thick liquid.

Common Cysts formed

- **Epidermoid cyst** is considered to be the most commonly occurring cyst. If trauma takes place close to the hair follicle, it forms in the skin's top layer. The skin's top layer grows inward instead of sloughing off like it is expected to be. The material present in such cysts is 'cheesy', comprising of 'dead' skin cells.
- **Sebaceous cysts** are quite similar to the above type. But their origin point is deep within the hair follicle. An oily substance referred to as sebum is filled in this cyst that

sebaceous glands excretes it. The **Best Dermatologist London** can diagnose the type and provide proper remedy.

- **Ganglion cysts** form around the joints, typically, the feet and the hands. It is also called as 'Bible bumps', thus referring to old home-remedy to whack the cyst using a heavy cyst such as the Bible. The attempt here is to break the tissue sac.

In recent times there has been an upward rise in skin cancer cases. This skin condition is characterized by the abnormal growth of cells on the epidermis. A vast majority of them can be treated easily. However, some of them can turn out to be serious and may even lead to death if they are not treated on time.

Other types

There are also other types of cysts like Pilonidal cysts (forms near tailbone at buttocks region), Baker's cysts (right behind the knee), epididymal cysts (on testes), etc. They generally form on the arm, face, back, scalp and face region.
