The capital of the Philippines does not always make the news for the right reasons, but if you wish a vibrant & underappreciated city, Manila is all set to challenge your assumptions. Let's find out some of the best things to do Manila.



## SAN AUGUSTIN CHURCH:

Started at the end of the sixteenth century, this remarkable building is a UNESCO site & the oldest stone-built cathedral in the Philippines.

The church is in the glorious Baroque style and necessitates a trip for its stupendous interior where trompe l'oeil paintings on the barrel vault and pilasters replicate reliefs, pediments, laurels, rosettes and other intricate mouldings.

## **SAN AUGUSTIN MUSEUM:**

The monastery affixed to the church was ruined during the 2<sup>nd</sup> World War, but was reconstructed in the 1970s and its previous cafeteria, crypt, sacristy, library and halls now hold a museum. This is an intuition into Manila's imposing years & the history of the Catholic faith in the Philippines. There is a big cache of religious art including wooden statues, paintings, antique missals, furniture, old vestments and altars brought here from cathedrals across the country.

#### **CHINATOWN:**

At first look Chinatown of Manila does not look like much of a sightseer spot; it's loud, a bit run-down and the traffic is usually in gridlock. But it aids to remember that there has been a Chinese trading presence in the province since the 800s, and this neighbourhood, known as Bindondo, grew as an adjacent town for the troubled Hokkien Chinese immigrant and their successors all through the Spanish colonial age.

The ideal way to explore it is from a calesa or jeepney.

It deserves your time for the Kuang Kong & Seng Guan Buddhist shrines, and the herbal shops and vendors along Carvajal and Ongpin Streets.

#### **RIZAL PARK:**

Rizal Park is Manila's biggest public park and is pretty dear to the Filipinos because of its historical significance. It's one of the best places to visit in Manila, Philippines. Today, the park is spread over 140 acres and has lovely ornamental gardens, statues of historical figures, a Central Lagoon with musical fountains, as well as an Orchidarium. Also locally known as Luneta Park, is one of the best tourist spots in Manila for couples who like to stroll in its beautiful avenues and lawns.
