Windows 10 Creators Update Installation Failure Error 0xc1900101-0x4000d

This error 0xC1900101-0x4000D mainly occurs in Windows 10/11 update version installation. Many users have informed that they are getting this windows 10 update issue while the second phase booting with migration data operation process running. Usually, this windows update error code 0xc1900101-0x4000d occurs when the upgrade process fails to migrate data to the new operating system

How to Avoid Windows 10 Installation Fails With Error Code 0xC1900101-0x4000D?

Before you update/upgrade any operating system, you should follow some steps to avoid unwanted errors.

- Check to make of your computer and model, whether it supports the new update you want to install
- Check pre-requisites for versions you are installing.
- Backup your old version through the restoring point.
- Try to make is of a new version to install easily.

Why the Computer Often Shows Errors While Operating System Update?

You may see this code 0xC1900101-0x4000D when windows 10 update failures mainly because of version switching not happening smoothly.(when you try to jump version to 1703 by skipping all updates it needed). Make sure you have the latest version and build number before updating to version 1703 of windows 10.

Windows 10 Creators Update Error Code 0xC1900101-0x4000D?

Check whether you have installed all updates regarding the operating system. If you have already tried and encountered the same issue several times, then follow these steps.

Windows Updates Troubleshooting Tool -

Use windows update readiness tool to fix many windows update errors like 0xC1900101-0x4000D, 0x4001e. Otherwise, use windows update readiness tool (if you are IT professional or support agent) and get suitable KB to fix update issues.
